Meeting called to order by Deralee Bowlin, President at 6:33 PM

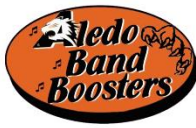
**Treasurer's Report** - Jeanne Klanssek, Treasurer, reviewed budget. Already made \$856 in restaurant nights. Membership \$4,500. Merchandise will continue to make more money as we sell the merchandise. Trish motioned to approve the budget and seconded by Jeff Streetman.

**Membership** – Kimberly Rossi, Secretary, reviewed the progress with the membership drive with 139 members signed up. We will be taking memberships online through Oct 26th. Membership merchandise delivered that evening. Jeanne motioned to approve the minutes and seconded by Kim McCluer.

**Merchandise** – Trish Belt, Merchandise Chair, we will be selling merchandise at the games and on-line. There will be senior shirts available for sale for students and parents. Profits will go directly to the scholarships. The next two games are extravabandza and senior night and will need additional parent support to sell merchandise. We sell merchandise before the game until right after halftime.

### Fundraisers –

- ShopWithScripts – Next order is Nov 12<sup>th</sup>. For December orders for Christmas there will be two order dates: Dec 3<sup>rd</sup> and Dec 14<sup>th</sup>.
- Restaurant Nights – All day on Oct 8<sup>th</sup> at East Parker Coffee with a 15%. Oct 18<sup>th</sup> at Applebee's on I-30 near Ridgmar Mall. Nov 1<sup>st</sup> at Schlotzsky's in Hudson Oaks. When attending please notify restaurant that you are there for the Aledo Band Fundraiser to ensure we get credit.
- Snaprraise - \$15,642 raised so far which is above our goal of \$10,000! This is a fundraiser for the students only not the parents. Funds are split 50/50 to ABB/student.
- Sherwood Forest Wreaths – Each kid will get a packet with booklet, order form and FAQs. There is a mini-site to direct customers to order on-line. Direct ship can be on-line as well on the mini-site. Each grade rep will be responsible for the wreaths (drop-off and pick-up of packets). Fundraiser starts next Monday, October 15<sup>th</sup>. Deliver 1-2 weeks after Thanksgiving. Includes those being ordered on-line. Be looking for more information that will be sent out via social media.
- Auction Concert and Dinner – Team meeting afterwards.
- Car Show – Evaluating as a fundraiser opportunity. Scope of fundraiser includes: location in AHS parking lot. Judges will award for best interior, best paint job, etc. Need sponsors (Express Auto, Tire Co., etc.) Targeting April 2019. Charge \$25 per car, vendor #, sponsors, t-shirts. Would be up to us what we want to charge and would require minimal help. Other bands have indicated that they have raised \$4,000 - \$5,000 on this type of fundraiser.
