Chaperones:

The chaperones will be with you all day/evening. We will be wearing our orange shirts. We will be easy to spot in a crowd. That is why we have the orange shirts. We are there to help you. We want all students to know, especially freshman / new students that if you have a problem or questions of any kind, you can come to ANY of us in an orange shirt. We can get ahold of a director if need be, if one is not directly with us.

Inhalers: If you use an inhaler, please be sure you bring it with you. Please be sure to have it with you at all times. Please do not leave it on the bus. We will not necessarily be by the bus when and if you need it. These competitions require a lot of walking from warm-up area, to performance area, to picture area, to trucking area, etc. Each area is not always close to the next.

Medications: If you will be needing to take medication while we are at the HEB contest, please bring the medication to Jenny McBrayer at 7:00am on Saturday morning. NO EXCEPTIONS! If medication needs to be given to your student while on the bus, the medication will be given to their bus chaperone to carry.

Students or parents need to bring all meds to the band hall at 7:00am on Saturday, September 29th. The meds must be placed in a labeled Ziploc bag (like the snack sized bags) for each dose.

Each bag should be labeled in the following way:

Name of Student

Name of medication

Day of week to take

Time of day to take

Example: If a student is on something twice a day, there will be 6 baggies for a 3 day trip.

Students: If you are needing Tylenol, Advil, Pepto, etc. Please see Mrs. McBrayer. If you cannot find me, please go to any chaperone. They will be able to find me.

Parents: Please do not send medication of any kind with your student to carry on their own. This is for their safety and the safety of others. We have over-the-counter meds with us and access to medical forms at all times._

Per Mr.Paul – All students will ride the bus home. No one checks out early. This is true for all home district season football games and contests.
